The introduction needs to report the innovation context, what is new about the proposed innovation in comparison with similar products/processes/services already in the market, the objective of the paper.

METHODOLOGY OR TACTICS (Title Times New Roman, 12 font size, bold). Methodology or Tactics must be written in max 400 words and with 12 font size, Times New Roman, justified, 1.5 line spacing. The Methodology or Tactics must describe the methods, steps and processes, applied in detail for developing the innovation reporting (if any) references to published methodologies, if applicable.

RESULTS (FIELD DATA) AND DISCUSSION (Title Times New Roman, 12 font size, bold). This section must be written in max 1000 words and with 12 font size, Times New Roman, justified, 1.5 line spacing. Presentation of the results obtained and result interpretation by comparing with other studies or generally accepted knowledge in the field. If possible, use descriptive figures (max 2) or tables (max 2) or figure & table (max 1 figure and 1 table) rather than explain in text.

CONCLUSIONS WITH TANGIBLE BENEFITS FOR FARMERS (Title Times New Roman, 12 font size, bold). The conclusions must be written in max 200 words and with 12 font size, Times New Roman, justified, 1.5 line spacing. Conclusions should include theoretical and/or practical implications of the proposed innovation with any exceptions, problems, or limitations of innovation use (if any), and any other useful recommendation.
